Return on investment. Every year corporate America reports on the return on investment to their stockholders in their annual report. How much did you get back? What was the dividend? How great was the return? In a capitalistic and consumeristic environment, we are interested in what we will receive.

At *Fair Haven*, our annual report should tell stories that are just the opposite. Rather than reporting what you have received for your money this year, we should communicate how we made investments for God's kingdom and the incredible return that was received.

Return on investment in ministry comes from conversations I have with guests and regular attenders who share with me about how their marriage was almost over and through *Hope Harbor* they are now putting it back together with God's help. It is seeing kids attend *PumpkinPalooza* and *EasterPalooza* and having a parent tell me about how their child accepted Jesus Christ at one of these events. It is a man coming forward for prayer on Sunday morning acknowledging his struggle with sexual sin and pornography, and the Holy Spirit's power to work in his situation and bring healing and restoration. It comes from a family in Jenison who has received food from *Hand2Hand Ministries* and is able to make it through these challenging financial times as one of the parents has lost a job.

As you read through the pages of this Annual Report, I hope it will cause you to break out in prayers of praise and gratitude for the significant ways God has been at work in the past year. By investing in God's kingdom, you are able to see statements, statistics, and stories that don't ask: *What did I get this year?* Instead, you will discover: *What did Fair Haven give this year?*

Through time, like *Kingdom Assignment 3*; through financial commitments, like weekly giving and our Thanksgiving Mission Offering; and through serving, like the hundreds of volunteers that use their gifts in ministry from *Fair Haven Kids* to *Kids Hope USA* to *His Image Ministry* and more, we are making a significant kingdom investment that will bring extensive and eternal returns.

At the end of each year as I reflect on where God has taken us as a church, I am in awe. It is amazing to see God's blessings, and to see the faithfulness of the *Fair Haven* family in investing those blessings in the lives of others. It causes me to lift up prayers of praise and thanksgiving – for God's blessing in pastoring such a wonderful church with such great people, for being a part of a movement of God's kingdom that is seeing new people get connected to Jesus Christ and grow in their commitment to Him, and to recognize the change that is taking place as hearts and lives are transformed through the ministry of *Fair Haven*.

- Seven *Harbor Lights Homecoming* events reached an average of 553 people each month involving the Fair Haven Worship Choir, soloists, duets, and quartets. This Southern Gospel ministry has been an effective outreach in our community and has blessed an inter-generational constituency.
- The children's musical, *Aaron the Allergic Shepherd*, involved over 40 children in music, drama, and dance in December.
- Special Services: *Orchestral Easter and Christmas Worship Celebrations* with over 80 musicians, dancers, and singers at each.
- Over 3,000 people attended the three Christmas Eve Worship Celebrations complete with an outdoor petting zoo.
- A new emphasis on scenic design emerged to enhance corporate worship for all message series and seasonal events.
- A partnership with Turning Pointe Dance has engaged dozens of children in our community in weekly classes.

- 28 new families with children connected this year to *Fair Haven* and are attending regularly.
- *Backstage with the Bible* VBS shared the gospel with 391 kids from *Fair Haven* and the community. Out of those who attended, one in three was from the community.
- *Fair Haven* launched the first *KidLead* club in Michigan this fall with 12 leaders. *KidLead* is a leadership development program for future influencers, ages 10-13.
- *PumpkinPalooza* and *EasterPalooza* outreach events were held attracting over 1,500 and 1,200 people each. About half of the people who came were families from the community!
- Over 300 volunteers invested their time in the next generation by serving on Sundays and Wednesdays.
- *The Learning Ship Christian Preschool* completed its 10th year of ministry with 98 children enrolled.



- Six interns in *Student Ministries* helped multiply relational ministry into the campuses of local high schools, building new relationships and impacting the lives of students.
- Volunteer, Kevin VanderGraaf, took on the challenge of becoming an intern and beginning a new youth ministry at *South Harbor* in partnership with Young Life. He knows over 100 students at Byron Center High School and holds a regular youth group meeting every Sunday.
- A number of different outreach events were held including a rock concert featuring Fever Fever.
- A new leadership team began a college ministry, now reaching more than 30 students from local colleges.
- This summer, over 100 people are going on four mission trips and three discipleship trips (middle school, high school and college).

The Word for Your Life

- Hundreds of people read through the New Testament in the fall in our *Thru the New* initiative, some for the first time ever. This was accompanied by a new survey class on the New Testament on Wednesday nights.
- Over half of our worshipping congregation participated in small groups this year.
- The Momentum Conference featured 41 break-out sessions with topics about leadership, revitalization, and church multiplication. 311 leaders attended from 65 different churches/organizations, with over 50 leaders from *Fair Haven* present.
- Eight Commissioned Pastor Candidates began meeting monthly for training in ministry.
- *Fair Haven* supported two full-time and one part-time seminary students.
- Women continued to be blessed through relationships with one another and the weekly Bible teachings of Kay Arthur, Beth Moore, and Lynelle Pierce.
- The Chick-Fil-A Leadercast conference was a great time of learning at *Fair Haven* for people from 16 different local companies and organizations.

- Teachers at Sandy Hill Elementary School and Jenison High School were blessed by a morning prayer time called Re-Fuel. A third Re-Fuel, led by another church, began in Bursley Elementary School.
- Approximately 14 volunteers, in partnership with other churches, provided foot care and haircuts to approximately 70 people in Grand Rapids.
- *Side-By-Side Ministry* completed its eighth training. 46 people have completed training since its inception, many of whom are currently serving as mentors.
- *His Image Ministry (H.I.M.) Fun Sundays* took place once a month, a *Caregiver's Support Group* began, five G.L.U.E. assessments have been provided to families, and *HIM Worship* began this year.
- 46 Touch of Home boxes were sent to military personnel.
- 111 meals were delivered to families of *Fair Haven* following the birth of a new baby in the past year or a hospitalization.
- 62 elderly received visits from staff and Pastoral Elders, totaling 345 visits.
- Approximately 86 people were served by borrowing medical equipment.
- A Memory Loss Support Group began.
- Over 200 people participated in the Good Friday stations of the cross prayer walk.
- 55 Prayer partners consistently pray for staff.
- A weekly student prayer group began.



It has been a privilege for me to be a part of *His Image Ministry* over the past few years and to see it grow into a multi-faceted ministry. To welcome and involve every person into community is beneficial to all who participate; it will be exciting to see what *H.I.M.* will look like in the future!

- *Hope Harbor* has held two sessions of *DivorceCare* and *DC4K (DivorceCare for Kids)* at Sandy Hill Elementary this past year.
- Five new classes were offered this year, three of which were marriage enrichment classes, one Bible study for single women, and *Experiencing God*.
- Nearly 40% of our leaders are new leaders that have taken the classes at *Hope Harbor*.
- Plans were made to add two new classes for the fall: *The Big D-DivorceCare Class for Teens*, and *Single and Parenting*.
- *Hope Harbor* has had a total of over 275 participants this past year.

- Compassion Sunday saw over 45 children sponsored in Awassa, Ethiopia.
- The Church2Church Ambassador Program was established with Believers Church in Awassa, Ethiopia in partnership with Willow Creek, and Compassion International.
- *Fair Haven* received the Mission Impact Partner Award from the Reformed Church in America for our global mission support.
- *Fair Haven* members toured four cities in India with Mission India and sponsored the first of dozens of future church plants.
- *Fair Haven* joined the China Partnership and continues to stand with the Chinese church which is both rapidly growing and oppressed.
- Relief funding was sent to Haiti and Japan, and ongoing rebuilding efforts were supported.

“India is a country of over a billion people and less than 3% are Christian. When I visited there I was amazed by the diversity in culture, religions, and languages! But I was also overwhelmed with a sense of hopelessness when walking their city streets. - Mission trips to Pine Hills and Sarasota, Florida provided much needed assistance to urban church plants.

- This fall we saw the launch of our first multi-site campus, *South Harbor*, on 10.10.10 with 475 in attendance. Since then, *South Harbor* has averaged 335 in worship each week and 550 at the Easter Worship Celebration.
- Over 80 people became partners at *South Harbor* and members of *Fair Haven Ministries*.
- *South Harbor* hosted a Church Multiplication Summit for the Synod of the Great Lakes with writer and speaker Alan Hirsch in January.
- 11 new small groups were started, 9 babies were baptized, 4 block parties were hosted, as well as *PumpkinPalooza*, *EasterPalooza*, and a Doll Tea Party Outreach.
- *Hand2Hand Ministries* at *South Harbor* is feeding 40 children from 2 elementary schools in Byron Center
- Over \$40,000 was raised for the Thanksgiving offering, Japan relief, *Hand2Hand Ministries*, the Care Fund, Church Planting, and Local Missions.
- *South Harbor* became a chartering organization for the Boy Scouts of America Cub Scouts 3313, Venturing 2313, and Boy Scouts 313.
- *SH Kids* regularly has between 65 and 100 children on Sunday and our youth ministry has over 20 kids in weekly attendance.

- The *Food Ministries Team* prepared and served over 100 meals for regular and special events and provided for three fundraisers to support various ministries of *Fair Haven*, including *South Harbor's* kitchen crew.
- The *Facilities Team* provided oversight and skill in the production of *Worship Center* stage set-ups.
- The *Master Planning Team*, a task force of the Administrative Consistory, conducted a short and long range survey to identify facility needs and to help in future planning.
- The *Finance Team* developed a revised Financial Plan to provide the most in ministry using available funding for the *Main Campus*, *Rock Harbor*, and *South Harbor*.
- The Ministry Opportunities Booklet has been developed to streamline communications and share the various ministries of *Fair Haven*.
- *The Anchor*, *Fair Haven's* newsletter, continues to share stories of how God is moving in the lives of people.
- A centralized communication plan was implemented to provide effective communication at all three campuses.
